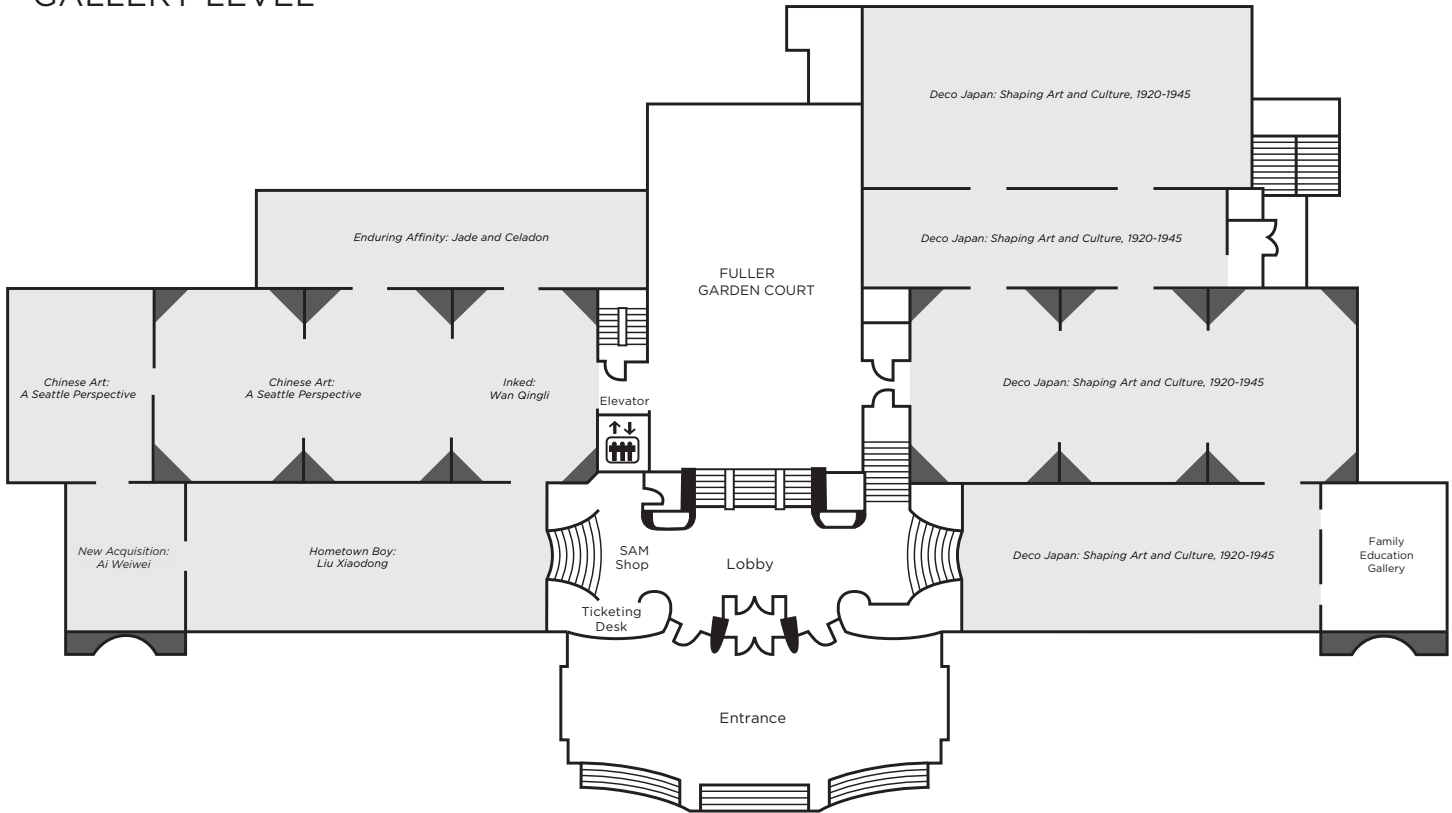

This historic Art Deco building originally housed the Seattle Art Museum's entire collection, from 1933 to 1991. After building an additional museum downtown, SAM devoted the beloved Volunteer Park museum to its world-renowned collection of Asian art. The Asian Art Museum strives to exhibit Asian art from across cultures and across time, including highlights from contemporary artists working in Asia today.
