**Title:** Gardening Assistant Intern

**Department/Location:** Olympic Sculpture Park

**Staff Mentor:** Lead Gardener

**Learning Objectives:** Assist gardeners in daily tasks, learn pruning techniques, and fundamentals of day to day operations and maintenance.

**Intern Tasks:** Work with gardeners directly on tasks involving park maintenance.
