Biography for older students that traces the events that shaped the Wyeths' art, as well as how each generation influenced the other.

I Know Here by Croza, Laurel and James, Matt. Berkeley: Groundwood Books: House of Anansi Press, 2010. CAI Sub Pla Cro

A tale about a young girl who draws pictures of her home, to help remember when her family moves across country.

Landscapes by Bodden, Valerie. Mankato, MN: Creative Education, 2012. CAI Sub Pla Bod

Examines the genre's origins and introduces its notable artists, works, and styles throughout history.

Landscape and the Environment by Bingham, Jane. Chicago: Raintree, 2006. N 8213 B56

Explores the theme of landscape and environment as depicted by artists.

Painting: Behind the Scenes by Pekarik, Andrew. New York: Hyperion Books for Children, 1992. CAI Med Pai Pek A book for children showing how to look at paintings and think like an artist, illustrated with fine art examples.

People by Yenawine, Philip. New York: Museum of Modern Art; Distributed Art Publishers, 2006. CAI Sub Peo Yen Explores how people are depicted by artists and how they help to convey meaning in art.
